Type of Incident: Potential risk during emergency situations Long Term Preventative Action:

- Ensure all educators are aware of Emergency and Evacuation Procedures and their role in the event of an emergency
- Ensure service practices emergency and evacuation drills on a regular basis
- Ensure all educators maintain active supervision and awareness of the children in care
- Ensure educators maintain awareness of environment/weather conditions whilst outdoors.
- easily assessable in the event of an emergency. Ensure emergency bags, first aid supplies, rolls, staff roster, emergency contacts and mobile phone are regularly checked and
- Support all children to understand emergency and evacuation procedures and expectations where possible
