Emergency and Evacuation Report

Drills are to be scheduled at random as not to develop a consistent pattern.

Orderly and well-executed emergency drills may be the means of saving lives.

Occasionally an exit should be blocked to provide a means of using alternate exits.

ALL EXIT DOORS AND MEANS OF EXIT SHALL BE KEPT UNBLOCKED

AND UNLOCKED / UNFASTENED WHILE THE BUILDING IS OCCUPIED.

Emergency evacuations must be done every 2 months, it is best practice to practice alternate drills (i.e. lockdown) on top of this.
