About our room...

Leaving your child in a new environment for the first time can be an exciting but also daunting experience. We understand that all babies settle at different rates. When you first bring your child into our education and care setting we encourage you to spend as much time as you need to settle in.

Routines

We cater for all children's differing routines and needs. We follow any routines that you may have or use in your home environment to keep consistency and familiarity in your child's day. This allows children to transition from the home environment to our environment feeling safe and secure.

Communication

Communication between families and educators is vital in providing high quality care for your child. We use communication books for your child to ensure the communication between families and educators is consistent.

Meals

We provide full cream cow's milk. If your child drinks formula you will need to bring this from home. New Food Laws suggest that powered formula needs to be bought in dry, so we can make the bottles fresh as required. The formula needs be given in a sealed container and left at the centre until expiry which is 4 weeks after opening. We provide food suitable for your child to each at different ages this includes puree vegetables or fruit, a pureed version of the lunch provided for the day or the meal provided on the menu.

Bedding

Please provide a sheet set (including a fitted sheet) to stay at the centre. This will need to be clearly labelled. Your child will have a regular cot to sleep in while in our centre. Cots are shared by other children, however they are cleaned and disinfected thoroughly between uses.

Medication and illness

If you think your child is ill, please speak to one of the educators so we can discuss the policies around illnesses and exclusions for certain illnesses. If your child requires medication during the day, please fill in a medication form and let a staff member know. Please remember that if your child is on medication, they need to stay at home for at least 24hrs from first administration. This gives the medication time to sink in. If your child requires Panadol and/or Nurofen during the day you are required to provide this. We cannot administer Panadol for more than 2 days in a row without a doctor's certificate.

Sun safety

We endeavour to allow children to play outside every day. Sunscreen will be applied 20 minutes before going outside. It is extremely important that you pack a hat every day in your child's bag. We recommend that all children have t-shirts with sleeves. If your child has sensitive skin you may wish to provide your own sunscreen.

What to bring

We ask all families to bring with their child;

- At least 5 nappies
- A water bottle
- A hat
- Bottles for milk / formula
- Any comforters
- Communication book filled in
- A change of clothes, plus a top in case of weather change

Please ensure all items are clearly labelled.

Safe sleeping

As per our services' 'Sleep, Rest, Relaxation and Clothing' policy, Babies will be placed on their back to rest. If a medical condition exists that prevents a child from being placed on their back, the alternative resting practice must be directed in writing by the child's registered medical practitioner. This guidance comes from Red Nose Australia.

Educational Program

Our Curriculum is based on the Early Years Learning Framework and involves careful planning and critical reflection which increases the value of children's time in our care. We ensure our educational program and practice responds to children's interests and scaffolds their learning. You as a family are children's first teacher and know your child best, it is important that you share information with us which we could use and include into our program and your child's individual learning. We believe having parents involved in our service enriches the educational program for our children. If you have any special talents or skills that you would like to come in and share with the children and educators please let us know!

Throughout the year, your child will explore and investigate through a range of activities and experiences whilst with us in the babies' room. We create a portfolio keepsake for you to take home at the end of the year where all these memories and experiences are kept.

Storypark

During your child's time with us, we use a range of different methods of documenting your child's learning journey. This includes Storypark, an online observation website and app for educators and families to interact with and document children's learning and experiences. Here you can watch your child's learning journey at our service, keep up-to-date with notifications, events, important information from the office and even share your own journey with your child with us!



The Storypark 'Families' app can be found in the app store of your mobile.

Storypark creates a secure online network of the people that matter most for your child. It helps working parents, far-away family, educators and specialists ensure children receive the best opportunities possible.

1 Sign up and log in

Once you accept the <u>email invitation</u> from your child's teacher you'll be taken to a <u>sign-up</u> page where you can enter your name and <u>choose a password</u>. Storypark is an online service, so you can <u>log in</u> without installing software on your computer.

Invite family

Share your children's stories by <u>inviting family members</u> and close friends. Create a private network of people to share and support your child's learning journey.

3 Comment and create

Parents, teachers and family can write <u>stories</u> and <u>comments</u>, add <u>pictures and videos</u>, and <u>select the children</u> who feature. Published stories will show up in your <u>child's profile</u>. Family members you have invited will get an email to say a new story has been added.
